Camp Lazarus is operated by the Simon Kenton Council, Boy Scouts of America, and is located on the west side of Highway 23 between Delaware and Lewis Center, across from the Delaware Area Career Center. Please carpool as much as possible, as parking is often limited during this popular event.

Daily Admission - the admission booth is open each day from 8:45 a.m. – 3:00 p.m. at our Welcome Center, adjacent to the main camp parking lot. All festival visitors must pay admission and will be issued a wristband.

Activities are open 9:00 a.m. – 4:00 p.m. each day. Activities are listed to the right, and we are always working to include more!

Pancake Feast is open from 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. in our camp dining hall. The feast includes pancakes, maple syrup, sausage links, and drinks. In the afternoon, hot dogs and chips are also available.

Dress Appropriately for winter conditions, please! Most activities are outdoors, and it is often cold, wet, and snowy.
